


ANTICIPATING THE NEW DAWN 2022

This can be highly detrimental to health safety. Thus, it is highly advisable for you to be sensitive to your physical strength and limitation. Do refrain from putting excessive stress to yourself at all times. Please ensure you have ample rest before accepting the next pilotage assignment as fatigue contributes to potential near miss and accident that eventually affect the general operation in the port or terminal.

Although the vaccination drives by the Ministry of Health of Malaysia (MOH)



has been successful in reducing the number of infection and death significantly, I would like to urge all members to continue to observe all the health safety precaution possible to avoid being infected and infecting others especially our family members and colleagues. The wearing of mask while onboard ship is still considered essential while the donning of FULL PPE for ships that arrive from critical ports remains.

The year 2022 is expected to be a recovering years for all of us in anticipating our daily life to resume normal gradually.
